Risk Index

A Risk Index is a single numeric value that encompasses any number of defined risk factors. It is a weighted average of each specified risk indicator as defined by the school district. Multiple indices can be customized to identify different types of risk. That means that each district not only can customize their individual risk indicators, they can define which indicators carry greater weight than others to calculate their truly unique set of Risk Indices. Each Risk Index can be sorted quickly so high-risk individuals are easy to identify and track.

- State assessments
- Other district-defined indicator
